Trinity was diagnosed with Langerhans Cell Histiocytosis (LCH) in August 2014 at the age of 7. She endured 36 months of treatment and multiple surgeries and complications. Trinity is now 14 years old and fully embracing life as a big sister and a decorated girl scout who uses her experience to give back to our community.





Meet Empress aka Storm! Empress was diagnosed with stage 4 Neuroblastoma in January 2011 at the age of 4. She was treated with chemotherapy, radiation, and stem cell transplant. Empress is now 15 years old and has been cancer-free for 10 years and is living life to the fullest!





Meet Mitchell aka Incredible Hulk! Mitchell was diagnosed with B-Cell non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma in June 2019 at the age of 4. He lost most of his vision from brain swelling caused by the cancer. Currently Mitchell is undergoing chemotherapy. His positive and witty personality along with his beautiful old soul are his sidekicks in his battle against cancer. A Loving Tribute to Kira. Kira was diagnosed with Stage 4, metastatic Ewing Sarcoma on December 28, 2016 at the age of 10. She persevered through 11 months of treatment with grace, a bit of humor, and faced her diagnosis like a champ! On January 31, 2018 Kira gained her angel wings.

In August of 2018, Jason Hook Photography and Space Coast Living Magazine did a spread focused on local "Survivors". This issue profiled local community leaders that have survived major obstacles in their lives. Shamika Chamberlin, Kira's mother, was featured as a bereavement survivor and Natasha Duran, Executive Director of Candlelighters, was featured for surviving Lupus. It was during that photoshoot with Jason Hook, that this Operation Superhero Program was brought to life for the children of Candlelighters. Thus, we offer this one time bereavement spotlight in honor and memory of Kira Chamberlin.




